### THE BIBLE TIMELINE: The Story of Salvation (24 sessions beginning 9/12)

Step One in The Great Adventure Bible Study Program, **The Bible Timeline: The Story of Salvation**, gives participants the "big picture" of Salvation history from its beginning in Genesis through the coming of Christ and the establishment of the Catholic Church.
