



A SYMBOL OF CHURCH UNITY

Fr. Joseph Asante Sunday Reflection



On the feast of the dedication of the Lateran Basilica, we emphasize that the church is a symbol of the Church Universal, built on Jesus Christ. That believers are a living temple where God's Spirit dwells. Holy Mother Church teaches with this feast the call to continuous spiritual renewal and to be a temple free from sin and commercialism (John 2:13-22). The Gospel reading focuses on Jesus

cleansing the physical temple as a metaphor for cleansing our hearts and on the vision of Ezekiel's life-giving river flowing from the temple. This symbolizes the grace received from Christ Jesus, the Savior.

Again, the Lateran as a symbol of the Church is the cathedral of the Bishop of Rome (The Pope). This symbolizes the unity of all Catholics with the Pope and it is the "mother and head of all churches". The following spiritual themes come to mind on this day.

- 1. The Church as a living presence of God: The common message here is that all Catholics as living stones form the spiritual house of God or the temple of God which is holy because the Holy Spirit dwells within it.
- 2. There is the need for constant renewal: As much as the physical temple needed cleansing, our hearts and souls require ongoing spiritual rebuilding and renewal. There must always be an ongoing conversion.
- 3. Remember Jesus as the foundation: Jesus is the foundation and cornerstone of the Church. We must know that no other foundation can be laid and that all believers are built upon him.
- 4. Significance of Ezekiel's vision of the river: This vision is interpreted as a symbol of the life-giving grace of Jesus flowing out to the world. The water represents the life of the Spirit that flows from Christ.
- 5. The cleansing of the temple by Jesus: His driving out the money changers out of the physical temple serves as a desire to cleanse our hearts from greed, commercialism, and sin. We must zealously make it a holy place of prayer and reverence.
- 6. There should be communion and unity: The feast is a reminder of our communion with each other in the body of Christ and the importance of maintaining unity, a unity nourished and perfected by the grace the flows from Christ.

Let us remember that the Church is One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic. Jesus is the foundation.
