



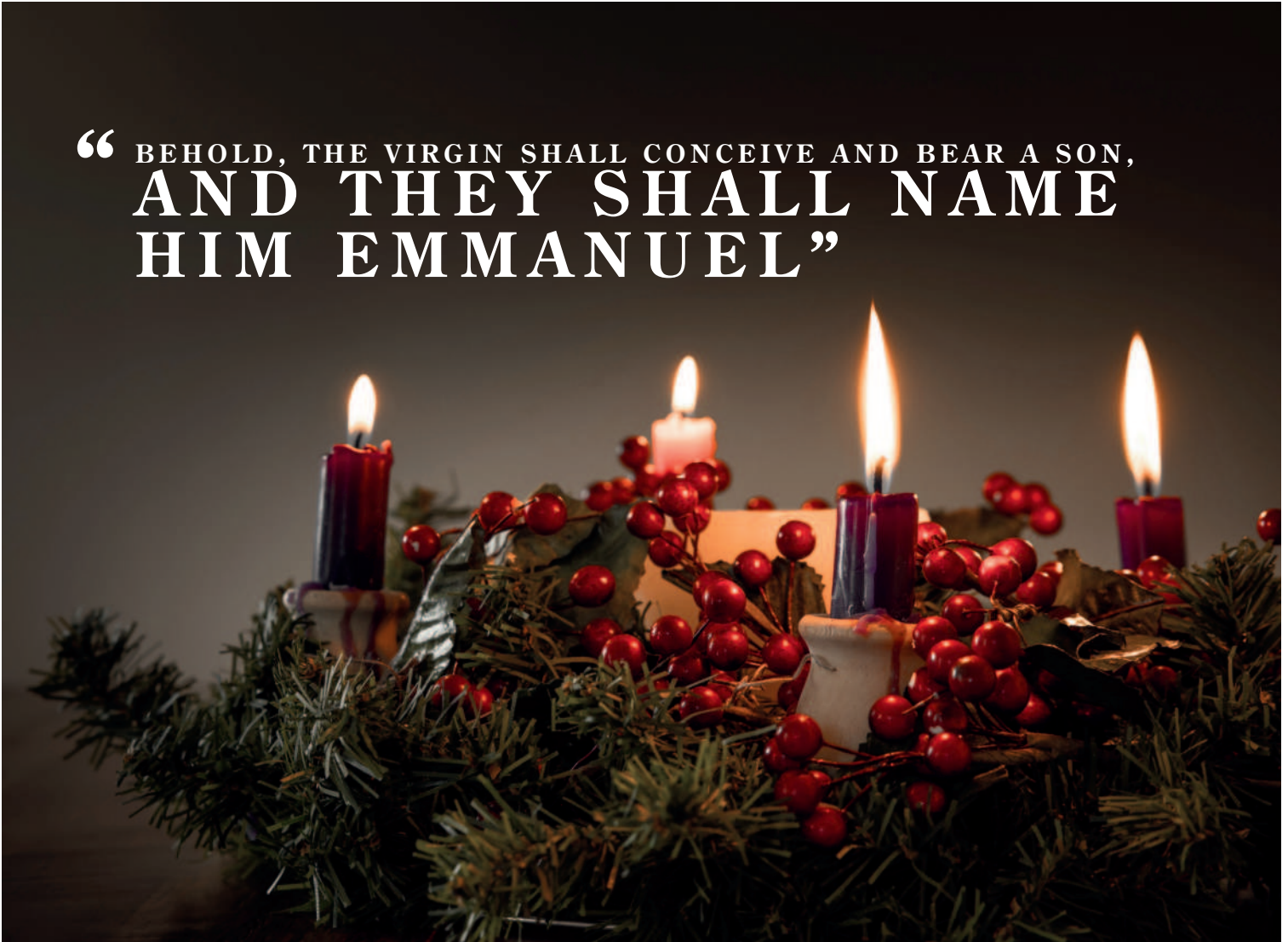

LOVE MADE REAL AND VISIBLE

Fr. Joseph Asante Sunday Reflection

The theme of Advent's fourth Sunday is the LOVE that God has for mankind to become man and save us from death and sin. There is also the lighting of the candle of love otherwise known as the "angel candle." It is in this fourth week of Advent that we reflect on the ultimate gift of love - Jesus Christ. Jesus is our true example of love, and He came to teach us to love God and others.

BIBLE VERSES FOR REFLECTION

"Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord." (Luke 2:11)

"Therefore, the Lord himself will give you a sign: The virgin will conceive and give birth to a son and will call him Immanuel." (Isaiah 7:14)

"The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth." (John 1:14)

"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life." (John 3:16)

"Out of his fullness we have all received grace in place of grace already given." (John 1:16)

"And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death—even death on a cross! Therefore, God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth." (Philippians 2:8-10)

"But when the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared, he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior, so that, having been justified by his grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life." (Titus 3:4-7)

"When they came to the place called the Skull, they crucified him there, along with the criminals - one on his right, the other on his left. Jesus said, 'Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing.' And they divided up his clothes by casting lots." (Luke 23:33-34)

"He told them, 'This is what is written: The Messiah will suffer and rise from the dead on the third day, and repentance for the forgiveness of sins will be preached in his name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things. I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high.'" (Luke 24:46-49)

REFLECTION ON TODAY'S READINGS

The readings help us focus on who Jesus is and why He came. We hear the name Emmanuel, which means "God is with us." This is the message we hold onto as we get ready to celebrate His birth. Each reading gives us something to think about. Isaiah speaks of a sign - a child born to a virgin.

Paul reminds the early Christians that Jesus was promised long ago. The psalm talks about who can come into God's presence. And in the Gospel, Joseph listens to God and chooses to stay with Mary.

CONCLUSION

These are not just stories from the past. They speak to us today. Like Joseph, we are asked to trust. Like Paul, we are called to share the good news. And like the people in Isaiah's time, we are told that God will not leave us alone.

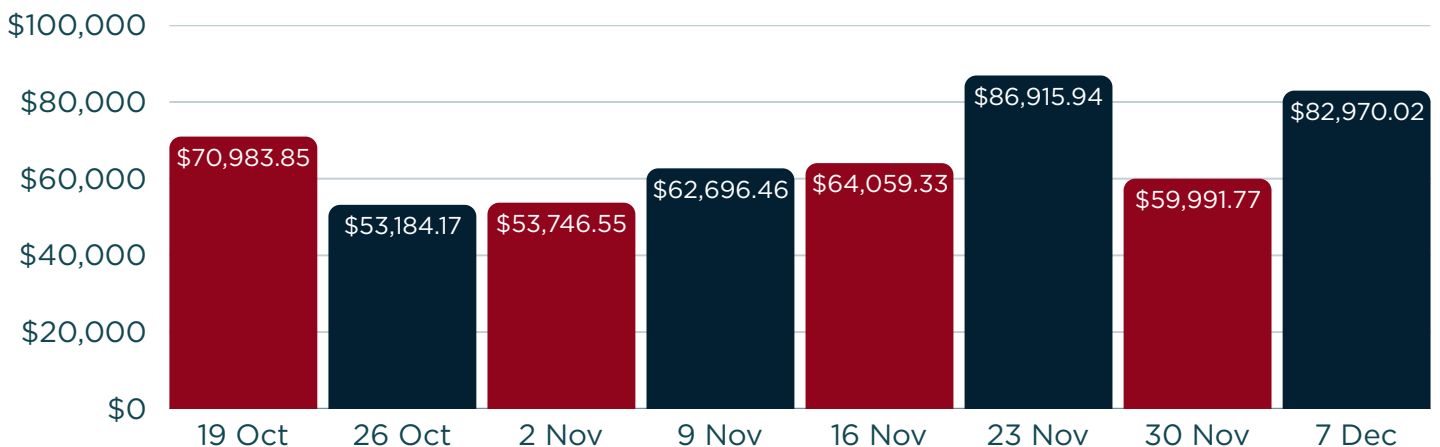
Thank you to all who have generously given to Sacred Heart this past year! You will be able to find your Annual Contribution Statement in your MyShoj Account by January 20th.

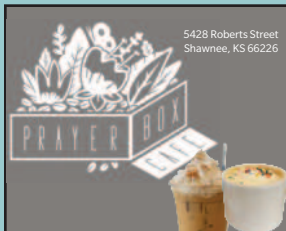

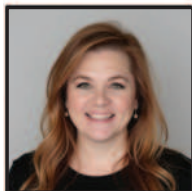
