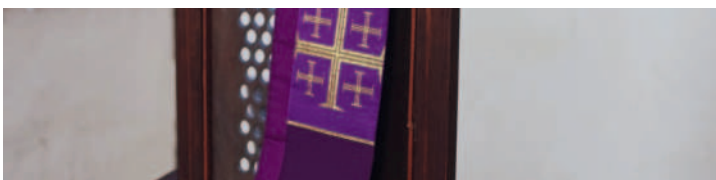


## VERSO L'ALTO MASS & DINNER

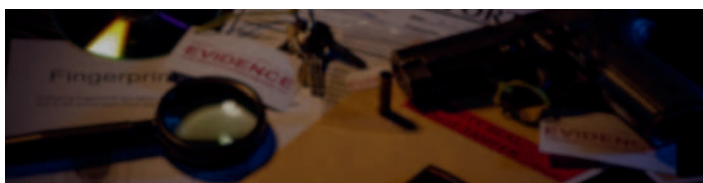

# THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

## Fr. Joseph Asante Sunday Reflection

The term “Epiphany,” based on the Greek word meaning “manifestation” or “revelation,” commemorates key events in the life of Christ: the visitation of the Three Wise Men, the baptism of Jesus in the River Jordan, and Christ’s first public miracle at Cana. Each reflects a moment of divine revelation.

The Feast of the Epiphany is rooted in the fourth century, instituted, in part, to emphasize the universal nature of Christ’s mission. It calls on us to reflect on the gifts given to Jesus: gold, symbolizing the Lord’s royalty; frankincense, used in the worship of God, signifies his divinity; and, myrrh, a burial ointment, points to Jesus’ redemptive Passion and death.

### WHO WERE THE THREE WISE MEN (MAGI)?

Although little is known about the Three Wise Men, tradition provides us with their names: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar. The Epiphany celebrates the moment Christ, the ultimate gift, was made known to the Three Wise Men and thus the Gentiles. Their journey is central, highlighting the global acknowledgment of Jesus as the Messiah. Tradition venerates the Three Wise Men as saints, including because they not only recognized Christ but also revealed him to the world. Their visit symbolizes the Gentiles finding Jesus (Isa. 11:10; Matt. 28:18-20) and expressing, through their gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh, who he is: King, God, and Savior (Isa. 60:6; Matt. 2:11). In doing so, they show that Christ himself is the greatest gift to all humanity.

### SEARCH OF THE NEWBORN MESSIAH

The Star of Bethlehem was likely not a miraculous light moving across the sky, but a real astronomical event, most likely involving the planet Jupiter. Ancient Babylonian astrologers, like the Magi, would have interpreted Jupiter’s rare movements as omens signaling the birth of a new king in the region of Judea. This interpretation fits both the Gospel account and known celestial events around 2 BC, offering a historically grounded explanation for why the Magi set out in search of the newborn Messiah.

### CONCLUDING FACTS

**Jesus as Light:** Jesus is the light that shines in the darkness. He guides all people to God.

**Universal Mission:** Jesus came for all nations and people. His salvation is not limited to one group.

**Inclusiveness:** Paul teaches that both Jews and Gentiles share in Jesus’ promises. The Epiphany shows that everyone is included in God’s plan.

**Guidance of the Star:** The star leads the Magi to Jesus. This shows God’s guidance to all who seek Him.

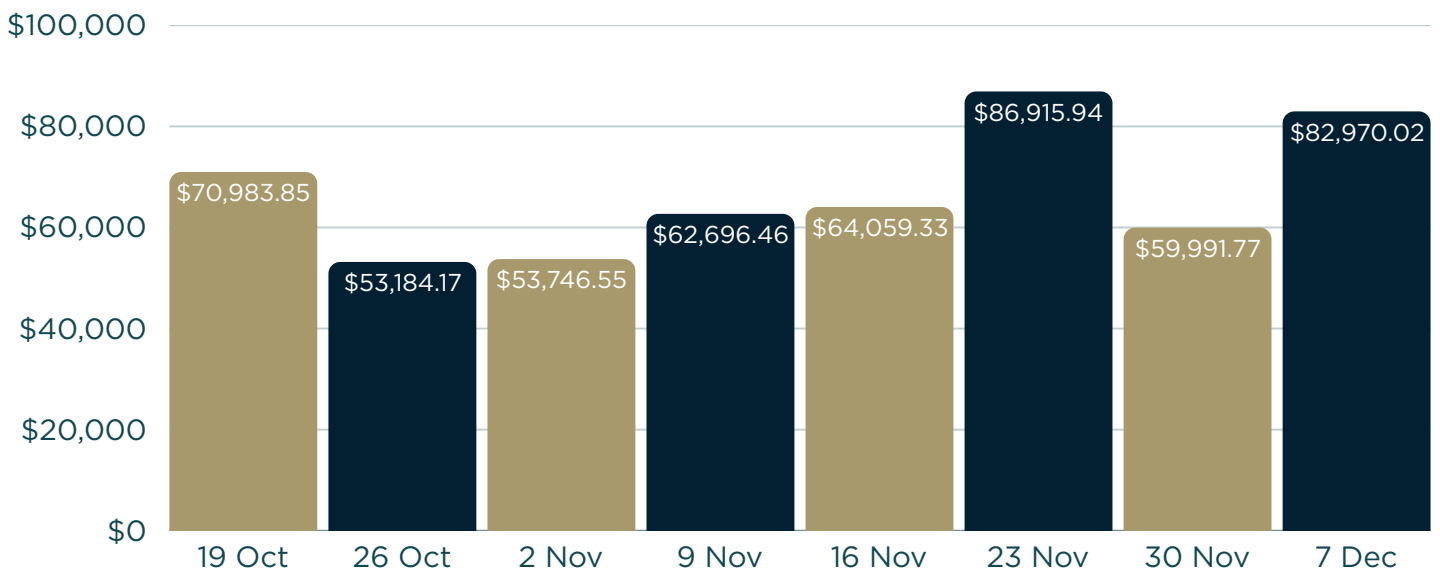

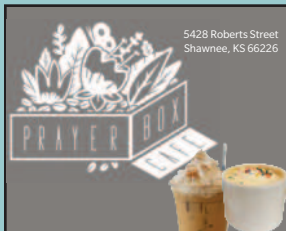
